

Oil Palm in Arunachal Pradesh State

Arunachal Pradesh was included under Oil Palm Area Expansion (OPAE), a sub scheme of RKVY, for oil palm cultivation during 2013-14 and National Mission on Oilseed and Oil Palm (NMOOP) from 2014-15 to 2017-18. State is also included under National Food Security Mission- Oil Palm (NFSM-OP) and implemented from 2018-19. State Department of Agriculture is a nodal agency for implementing the programme in the state. Presently, the programme has been implementing in 9 districts of Arunachal Pradesh viz; East Siang, Lower Siang, Kamle, Pampapare, Pakke Kesang, Lower Dibang Valley, Namsai, Tirap and Changlang.

Physical and Financial progress:

The details of oil palm area expansion target & achievement and financial fund allocation, release and FFB & CPO (GOI share) under MM-II of NMOOP (2014-15 to 2017-18) / NFSM-OP (2018-19 to 2021-22) are given below:

- During the year 2021-22, GOI has approved Annual Action Plan (AAP) of the State for an amount of Rs. 1441.96 lakhs, consisting of Rs. 1297.76 lakh as Central share and Rs. 144.20 lakh as State share for implementing NFSM-OP. An amount of Rs. 648.88 lakh has been released as a 1st instalment.
- District-wise private entrepreneurs involved in the State for oil palm development are M/s. Ruchi Soya Industries Ltd. in East Siang and Subansiri districts; M/s. 3F Oil Palm Agrotech Pvt. Ltd. in Dibang Valley district; and M/s. Shivasais Oil Palm Pvt. Ltd. in Namsai, Tirap and Changlang.
- An area of 4246 ha upto March 2021 has been covered under Oil Palm cultivation against of potential area of 133811 ha identified by re-assessment Committee 2020 which is 3.17% only.
- Govt. of India has proposed Oil Palm area expansion targets of 40000 ha for next 5 years from 2021-22 to 2025-26 under National Mission on Edible Oil-Oil Palm (NMEO-OP).

- GOI has approved Annual Action Plan (AAP) of the State for an amount of Rs. 1868.83 lakhs, consisting of Rs. 1685.40 lakh as Central share and Rs. 183.44 lakh as State Share Plan for coverage an area of 600 ha under Oil Palm cultivation during the year 2021-22 under NMEO-OP.

Oil Palm in Assam State

Assam state is also covered under NFSM-OP and implemented by Department of Agriculture. An area of 375428 ha has been identified potential for oil palm cultivation in three districts of the State. Only 2496 ha area has been achieved against potential area in two districts viz; Kamrup, Goalpara up to March, 2021.

Oil Palm in Manipur

The assessment committee 2012 did not recommended any potential area however, the reassessment committee 2020 identified 66652 ha in 6 districts. Namely, Bishnupur, Chandel, Churachandpur, Imphal west, thoubal and Ukhrul.

- GOI has approved Annual Action Plan (AAP) of the State for an amount of Rs. 839.19 lakhs, consisting of Rs. 755.26 lakh as Central share and Rs. 83.93 lakh as State Share Plan for coverage an area of 150 ha under Oil Palm cultivation during the year 2021-22 under NMEO-OP.

Oil Palm in Mizoram State

State Department of Agriculture is a nodal agency for implementing the oil palm development programme from 2004-05 in State of Mizoram. Presently, the programme is being implemented in 7 districts viz; Aizawl, Kolasib, Mamit, Serchhip, Lunglei, Lawngtlai and Saiha of the State under National Food security Mission – Oil palm (NFSM-OP). Under OPAE programme, three Oil Palm mills have been approved for Mizoram with financial support of Rs. 250 lakh each mill @ 50% of the cost of plant and equipments. Out of three, one mill has established and also started processing of Fresh Fruits Bunches (FFBs) of oil palm at Kolasib District in Mizoram. The work is in progress for other two mills. Government of India has approved two new seed garden for the State of Mizoram.

Physical and Financial progress:

The details of oil palm area expansion target & achievement and financial fund allocation, release and FFB & CPO (GOI share) under MM-II of NMOOP (from 2014-15 to 2017-18) & NFSM-OP (2018-19 to 2021-22) are given below:

- During the year 2021-22, GOI has approved Annual Action Plan (AAP) of the State for an amount of Rs. 1333.77 lakhs, consisting of Rs. 1200.39 lakh as Central share and Rs. 133.38 lakh as State share for implementing NFSM-OP. An amount of Rs. 600.20 lakh has been released as a 1st instalment.
- One Oil Palm processing mill has established and also started processing of Fresh Fruits Bunches (FFBs) of oil palm at Kolasib District in Mizoram and two other mills are to be established.
- An area of 26680 ha upto March 2021 has been covered under Oil Palm cultivation against of potential area of 66792 ha identified by re-assessment Committee 2020 which is 40%.
- The present FFB price for January 2021 in Mizoram State is Rs. 5500/- per MT.
- Govt. of India has proposed Oil Palm area expansion targets of 27000 ha for next 5 years from 2021-22 to 2025-26 under National Mission on Edible Oil-Oil Palm (NMEO-OP).

Oil Palm in Nagaland State

Agriculture Department is a nodal agency for implementing the oil palm development programme in Nagaland. State is included for Oil Palm Development Programme from 2014-15 and presently under National Food Security Mission – Oil palm (NFSM-OP). State has about 51297 ha area potential as per Reassessment Committee 2020 for oil palm cultivation in 7 districts viz; Dimapur, Peren, Mokochung, Wokha, Mon, Longleng and Kohima.

Physical and Financial progress:

The details of oil palm area expansion target & achievement and financial fund allocation, release and FFB & CPO (GOI share) under MM-II of NMOOP (from 2014-15 to 2017-18) & NFSM-OP (2018-19 to 2021-22) are given below:

- During the year 2021-22, GOI has approved Annual Action Plan (AAP) of the State for an amount of Rs. 555.56 lakhs, consisting of Rs. 500.00 lakh as Central share and Rs. 55.56 lakh as State share for implementing NFSM-OP. An amount of Rs. 250.00 lakh has been released as a 1st instalment.
- Only one entrepreneur viz; M/s. Shivasais Oil Palm Limited is playing active role in development of oil palm in the State of Nagaland.
- An area of 5172 ha upto March 2021 has been covered under Oil Palm cultivation against of potential area of 51297 ha identified by re-assessment Committee 2020 which is 10% only.
- Nagaland state is new for Oil Palm. At present, there is no mill. However, land site selected for setting up of Oil Palm processing mill in the State.
- Govt. of India has proposed Oil Palm area expansion targets of 30000 ha for next 5 years from 2021-22 to 2025-26 under National Mission on Edible Oil-Oil Palm (NMEO-OP).
